Is something missing? Is anything broken? Please let us know.

Please treat the house with care, as if it were your own.

On warm days, make sure to close the shutters at the front in the morning. In the afternoon, close the shutters on the garden side. This will help keep the temperature pleasant.

The shutters of the attic roof windows should also remain closed during hot weather. Important: always open the shutter of the large roof window completely before opening the window itself. The remote control for this is attached to the beam in the room.



The small attic window is locked for safety reasons. If you wish to open it, you can use the smallest key on the keyring. Never leave children unattended upstairs when the window is open.

Charging your electric car is not allowed.

Some areas are private and are marked as such. Please do not try to enter these spaces.

Please respect the neighbors by keeping noise down after 10 p.m.

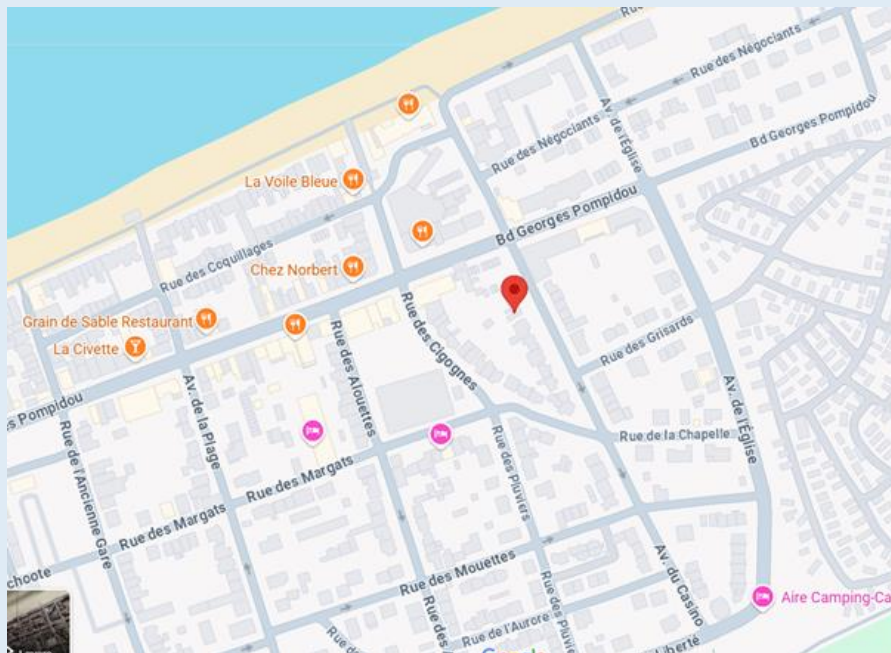


Parking

Waste & Recycling

We kindly ask you to sort your waste. To make this easy, three bins are available:

- **Yellow:** for all recyclable packaging, such as paper, plastic, metal, and Tetra Pak.
- **Green:** for organic waste, such as uncooked vegetables and peels. A small container is provided for this.
- **Black:** for all other residual waste.

Glass can be taken to the glass container located at the beginning of Avenue du Casino, on the seawall.



All bags can be collected in the black bin. Since all bags may be placed together in the container, please make sure they are well tied, preferably with a **double knot**. Garbage is collected on Monday morning. We kindly ask you to place the black bin outside on **Sunday evening** so it can be emptied.



Is the black bin full? You can also deposit your garbage bags free of charge at the *Camping Municipale*, located nearby at 100 Avenue de l'Église.



Upon your arrival, we will provide you with two garbage bags of each color. Not enough?

Using the Kitchen appliances

A detailed manual can be found in the top drawer to the left of the stove.

Oven

Start the oven by pressing the power button. Then select your program using the round dial.

Confirm your choice by pressing the dial. After that, you can adjust the temperature. Don't forget to press the arrow button, otherwise the oven will not start.

Cooktop

Turn on the cooktop using the power button.

Select the desired cooking zone by pressing the corresponding number.

You can then increase or decrease the heat setting.

The button at the bottom allows you to choose between the large or small zone of the selected cooking plate. Note that not all plates have this function.

Dishwasher

Turn on the dishwasher using the power button.

Select the desired program. It is set to '**ECO**' by default, but this setting is not recommended. We usually choose '**Automatic**'.

Don't forget to press the **Start** button (the last button) to begin.
